You will produce a nicer card if you use a heavier-weight paper that has a coating for inkjet printing instead of a plain-papercard stock. A favorite paper supplier of mine is [www.redriverpaper.com](http://www.redriverpaper.com).

← FOLD LINE: You will get a neater fold if you pre-score the paper. Lay a ruler along the two fold lines and use the blunt edge of a kitchen knife to create a straight, thin groove in the paper.
